Debra Dowden-Crockett is a glass and jewelry artist with a studio in Norfolk, VA. Debra has been working with glass, sculpting and painting with it in the torch, for seven years, continually challenging and sharpening her skills. Debra has been designing jewelry for more than 10 years.

Debra graduated from Baylor University with a B.A. degree in Philosophy. She minored in Chemistry, where she was first introducted to glass. For nearly 17 years, she served as Vice President of Business Develoment for a government contractor in Northern Virginia. In mid-2010, she left that position to pursue her passion for glass art. She was elected to serve as Vice President for the Mid-Atlantic chapter of the International Society of Glass Beadmakers from 2005 until 2006. In 2008, she was selected as a resident glass artist at The Workhouse, a complex of artist studios and galleries in Lorton, VA. Most recently, in September 2010, she was selected as an Artist in Residence at the prestigious Pilchuck Glass School in Stanwood, WA.

Debra is a member of the Peninsula Glass Guild, the Glass Art Society, and the International Society of Glass Beadmakers.
